

Q What is Wildflowers?

A Wildflowers is a Christ-centered discipleship program for girls in grades 3–6. Built on the legacy of Christian Service Brigade and thoughtfully designed specifically for girls, Wildflowers blends biblical discipleship, character formation, practical skills, outdoor adventure, and service into one intentional journey of growth.

The goal is to cultivate girls who are rooted in Christ, confident in their God-given identity, and growing into young women who reflect both feminine strength and an adventurous spirit.

Q How does Wildflowers relate to Christian Service Brigade?

A Wildflowers is developed within the ministry framework of Christian Service Brigade, extending its discipleship model into a program designed specifically for girls.

While honoring Brigade’s legacy of building godly men, Wildflowers provides a complementary pathway focused on discipling young women.

Q Who leads Wildflowers?

A Wildflowers is led by women mentors within the church who desire to disciple the next generation of girls. Leaders guide small groups, teach practical skills, encourage spiritual growth, and model Christlike character. The program is built around intergenerational discipleship, allowing girls to learn from women who have walked faithfully before them.

Q Do leaders need special training?

A Pilot churches will receive guidance and resources to help leaders prepare for the program. The curriculum is designed to be clear, structured, and accessible, allowing churches to implement Wildflowers with confidence.

Q How does the Wildflowers curriculum work?

A Wildflowers is designed to be simple and structured for churches to implement. The program is built around topical modules, each focused on a specific skill, character theme, or area of spiritual growth. Each module includes:

- A Leader Guide PDF with teaching outlines, discussion prompts, and activity instructions.
- A Wildflower Girl PDF for the girls to use during meetings.
- Four weekly lessons, allowing churches to complete one module over the course of a month.

Leaders simply download the module materials and guide their group through the weekly lessons. The curriculum is designed to be clear, practical, and easy for churches to lead without requiring extensive preparation.

Each meeting combines Scripture, discussion, hands-on learning, and practical skill development.
