



Cooking & Hospitality

Serving with Joy

This module teaches girls that preparing food and welcoming others is a meaningful way to reflect Christ's love. Through biblical examples like Martha and Lydia, girls discover that hospitality is not about perfection but about joyful service and generous hearts. Girls practice simple cooking skills, table setting, and hosting with thoughtfulness. They learn that the table can be a place of ministry, encouragement, and connection where Jesus is made known.



First Aid

Compassionate Service

The First Aid module equips girls to care for others with confidence, compassion, and wisdom. Through hands-on training and biblical role models such as Rahab, Florence Nightingale, and Clara Barton, girls learn that practical care reflects the heart of God. They practice basic first aid skills, safety awareness, and caregiving principles. By the end, girls understand that helping the vulnerable is both a skill and a calling.



Life in the Wild

Living in God's Presence Outdoors

This outdoor-focused module connects survival skills with spiritual truth. Girls learn about shelter, fire, food, and safety while exploring how each reflects God's protection, provision, and presence. Through hands-on experiences like tent setup and outdoor cooking, they gain confidence in nature. The spiritual parallel reminds them that just as God provides in the wilderness, He provides in every season of life.



Gardening

The Gospel in Gardens

From Eden to Gethsemane to the Garden Tomb and the Garden of Heaven, this module traces the Gospel through Scripture's gardens. Girls learn that God is the Gardener who plants, restores, and brings new life. Through planting, observing growth, and studying biblical events, they see how redemption unfolds from the beginning to eternity. Gardens become a picture of hope, restoration, and God's faithful plan.



Photography

Capturing God's Beauty & Reflecting His Image

Photography becomes a tool for worship, gratitude, and identity formation. Girls learn to notice and capture the beauty of God's creation while reflecting on the difference between outward appearance and inward identity. Through creative projects, they explore how images shape perception and how their true identity is found in Christ. Photography becomes a way to tell God's story.



Homecare & Maintenance

Stewardship & Capability

This module teaches practical home skills rooted in biblical responsibility. Girls learn that caring for a home honors God and serves others. Through simple repair skills, organization, and service-minded habits, they gain confidence and capability. Physical stewardship becomes a reflection of spiritual maturity.



Service

Loving Through Action

This module centers on serving others with humility and joy. Girls explore Jesus as the ultimate example of servant leadership and learn that service begins in everyday faithfulness. Through community projects and reflection, they grow in compassion, awareness, and willingness to meet needs around them.



Hiking, Maps & Compass

Following God's Path

Using navigation skills as a metaphor, girls learn that God prepares, guides, and establishes their paths. Through map-reading, hiking, and planning exercises, they discover the importance of preparation and trust. The module emphasizes listening for God's direction and remaining faithful when plans change.
